

**TRI-COUNTY MEN'S FASTBALL LEAGUE**  
**CODE OF CONDUCT**

Members of the Tri-County Fastball League are expected to treat umpires, players, coaches or any other member of the league in a respectful manner. If they do not, additional penalties will be enforced.

Ejections for illegal re-entry, or non conflict related ejections, will be suspended for the remainder of that game only.

Other ejections during or after the game:

1 <sup>st</sup> offence	0 additional games
2 <sup>nd</sup> offence	1 additional game
3 <sup>rd</sup> offence	2 additional games
4 <sup>th</sup> offence	4 additional games
5 <sup>th</sup> offence	8 additional games

For the purposes of the above suspensions each season will be considered to be separate, resetting offence numbers each year.

For verbally threatening an umpire, player, coach or any member of the league during or after the game or following an umpire off the diamond after the game is over, the following minimums will apply, with increased penalties possible at the discretion of the league executive: (5 year offence reset)

1 <sup>st</sup> offence	5 additional games
2 <sup>nd</sup> offence	1 year from the time of incident
3 <sup>rd</sup> offence	Life

Physically abusing an umpire at any time will be a 10 game minimum suspension with the league executive and umpire-in-chief to review to see if a stiffer penalty needs to be added.

The umpires must write up a written report within 48 hours to be given to the league president for offence tracking.
